TREASURER UPDATE YTD: APRIL 30

There are good things happening at Mt. Carmel as we continue to make a positive impact in meeting our goal to erase our faithfully passed deficit budget of (\$43,368). Congratulations on raising \$7910 of special gifts as of May 15. The balance needed to meet the \$10,000 match goal by June 30 is only \$2090. With the initial Foundation gift of \$6100 to specified areas of budget, we have potential to erase \$21,100 of the deficit by June 30 and we are almost at our goal.
